HOW WE CAN HELP YOU

If your child is eligible for a funding grant called `Pupil Premium, then you could receive support as follows:

- FREE school Sweatshirt !
- FREEschool Bookbag!
- · FREEschool PE Bag !
- · HELP with cost of school trips !

If you are entitled, and have already purchased these items, the school can give a refund. This offer cannot be repeated more than once a year.

What is Pupil Premium?

Pupil Premium funding is a government initiative that provides additional funding to schools so that they can support pupils to make optimum progress. It is used in many different ways and the school provides a summary of use on its website. However, the school can only receive this funding if parents, who are entitled, apply by completing the necessary form.

Is my child eligible for Pupil Premium funding?

It's easy to check if your child is entitled to benefit from this additional funding. All you have to do is go to the following web link: www.dorsetforyou.com/free-school-meals with your National Insurance number and date of birth and you will know if you are eligible straight away.

How do I claim my Free School Uniform?

As soon as we hear that you are entitled to Pupil Premium funding, the school office will contact you. The school office will provide you with the school book bag and P.E. bag and sort out a free sweatshirt.

You may also be entitled to Pupil Premium funding if any of the following applies to you:

- You are the parent of a child adopted from care
- You are in receipt of a Special Guardianship or Residence Order
- You are, or have been, entitled to the Service Child premium in the last 4 years
- You have been eligible for Free School Meals within the last 6 years

If this applies to you, please speak to a member of the Office Staff who will check your entitlement.

If you have any further queries please speak to the school office for more details, support or advice.


PTFA Movie Night Tues 31 January 4.15 - 5.45pm

School Attendance

As you are aware, we monitor attendance to make sure that all children are in school and have the opportunity to achieve their full potential.

Our attendance percentages by year group are currently:

Whole school overall attendance is 96.5% We discuss attendance with parents when the percentage falls below 95%, with the aim to have a whole school overall attendance figure of 97%.
